INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING PAINT COLORS

For all New Construction, Remodel and Repainting:

According to the Covenants, the standard for paint colors in Shelter Bay is a “harmonious color scheme”. There is no list of ‘disapproved’ colors, however, it is best to keep the colors subdued as the Building Committee has the discretion to reject the submitted colors and ask you to resubmit alternatives.

The Builder or Owner shall submit the application for the exterior wall and trim color(s). In the space provided, list each location, the color by Brand, name and color number. If there is insufficient space, please add a supplemental sheet. Attach to the Application a paint chip for each color identified with its brand, color name and number. If specific color chips are not available, submit a 4”x4” painted sample on hardboard. The committee, at its discretion, may require additional information. If there is any change of paint colors proposed prior to the final painting, a revised Application for Paint Approval form must be completed and new color chips submitted.

Painting a color different from submitted sample can result in a fine and/or requirement to repaint to approved color.
